Land and water are home—all living beings are First Nations’ relations—and this profound yet pragmatic approach to life helps to sustain First Nations beliefs, values, and resilience. Teaching is a lifelong practice in all First Nations, whether it occurs on the land, home, or at social events.

The Manitoba First Nations Education Resource Centre is proud to host this year’s First Nations Circle of Knowledge & Practices Conferences on October 3 & 4 at the Victoria Inn & Conference Centre in Winnipeg. Workshops and speakers at this year’s conference will focus on land-based teachings and language in the classroom and school.
