Yellowquill College, a First Nation owned and controlled college, is currently accepting applications for one full-time instructor to teach 9, 11 and 12 Math; 10, 11 and 12 English; 12 FNMI (Native Studies) and 12 Family Studies. This position in Bloodvein First Nation is to start as **soon as possible** until June 26, 2020.

Bloodvein First Nation is 210 kilometres north of Winnipeg on the east shore of Lake Winnipeg, directly north of the Bloodvein River. The community is situated along three kilometres of shoreline at the mouth of the river.

There is a 3,000 foot gravel airstrip maintained in the community. The community is also accessible by gravel road.
