Language and Literacy	1. BINGO	No materials needed	Sing the song "BINGO." Clap out the letters while singing.	https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=2E0hHjSwdW4
	2. Telephone	2 paper cups, string	Take the paper cups and put a hole in the bottom of each one. Tie a string through the cups. Use the telephone to say messages back and forth.	https://theresjustonemom.com/make-a-paper-cup-phone/
Numeracy	1. Colour Scavenger Hunt	A piece of paper with different colours drawn	Provide children with the paper, and have them go around the house or outside to find items that match the colours. Encourage them to place the items on the colour to match.	
	2. Memory Matching	Deck of cards	Lay out the entire deck of cards face up. Encourage your child to find two cards that match. Label the numbers when they	

			are picked up.	
Curiosity (Science)	1. Floor Tunnels	Paper, Tape, objects that roll	Take some paper and tape it to the floor as a tunnel. Have children roll or blow objects through the tunnels (ex. Pompom, cotton ball, small ball, cars, rolled up socks).	
	2. Tower Building	Paper plates, paper cups, toilet paper rolls, boxes, paper towel rolls	Give paper objects to your child and encourage them to build a tall tower.	
Social - Emotional	1. How Do You Feel Today?	Pictures of faces or emojis showing different feelings	Brainstorm with children about their feelings. Ask children how they feel and ask if they can show their facial expressions or match to the picture.

Self-Help/Adaptive

1. Tie your Shoe

Large piece of cardboard, markers, shoe lace or string, hole punch

Cut the cardboard box into the shape of a shoe. Punch holes into cardboard to place the shoe lace. Add shoe lace in the holes. Allow children to practice tying on the cardboard.



2. Brush your teeth

Toothbrush and toothpaste, water cup

Show children how to brush with a toothbrush. Encourage children to place a small amount of toothpaste on the toothbrush and brush their teeth.

Physical/Motor	1. Pillow Walk	All kinds of pillows	Lay out pillows in a path and have children move over it how they would like to. Great for balance!	 <p>Pillow Walk @FunSensoryPlay</p>
	2. Keep it Up	Balloon (or scarf, tissue paper, coffee filter)	Blow up a balloon. Encourage your child to keep the balloon in the air any way they can think of. If you do not have balloons, you can use a scarf or tissue paper or coffee filter.	
Creativity	1. Mud Painting	Container, Soil, Water, Brush or Sponge (if needed)	Take a container, fill it with soil from outside and add some water. Encourage children to paint with the mud, using hands or brushes.	 <p>© FunSensoryPlay Paint with Mud</p>
	2. Act Like...	No materials needed	With your child, pretend to be different animals by moving and making sounds (ex. dog, cat, turtle, wolf, bear, butterfly,	

			bird).	
Spiritual	1. Dance Jig	Fiddle music (Red River jig, Big John Mcneil), Jigging videos	Ask a child to join you in dancing the jig. Move your body to the fiddling music.	https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Xg2s9oKPSCo
	2. Animal tracks	Pictures of animal prints	Go out for a nature walk and look for animal tracks. Talk with children about the different types of animals and where the animals live.	
Learning Every Day (Tidying Up)	1. Where do they go?	Toys on floor	Encourage child to pick up the toys and say where they go.	
	2. How many?	Toys on floor	When cleaning up the toys, count each one as it gets put away.
