Specific Responsibilities

Teach Precalculus 30S within WVC's synchronous instructional model (LMS – Brightspace D2L and Web Conference (Adobe Connect)), scheduled daily from 10:00-11:00 a.m. Tasks related to instructing include: student support, maintaining student records, preparing course outline, a small amount of course development, ongoing student assessment (formative and summative).

Qualifications:

- Bachelor of Education Degree with valid Manitoba Teaching Certificate;
- One year (min.) teaching experience in the identified subject area;
- Ability to transition pedagogical skills to an online environment;
- Excellent presentation skills which include a demonstrated ability to work with current learning tools and technologies associated with online course delivery (i.e. Learning Management System (Brightspace D2L), Web Conferencing (Adobe Connect) and other Web 2.0 applications);
